What to record when researching

Credible Sources

Remember, we want to find CREDIBLE sources for our evidence.

So, NO.....

- Forums (where people can answer without using real names)
- Blogs / Wiki pages / Social Media posts

What you need...

- Title of website (URL address)
- Title of article / page
- Author(s)
- Date published / updated

You need enough information to get back to the source on another day!

You need all of this for a proper citation.

Write down any information that you want to use. Do not copy whole paragraphs of text. Write down quotes, or summarize material to use.

Example

I found this statistic from a website:

Dropout rate for non YRE schools

5 %

Average dropout rate for YRE schools

2 %

I write down this:
